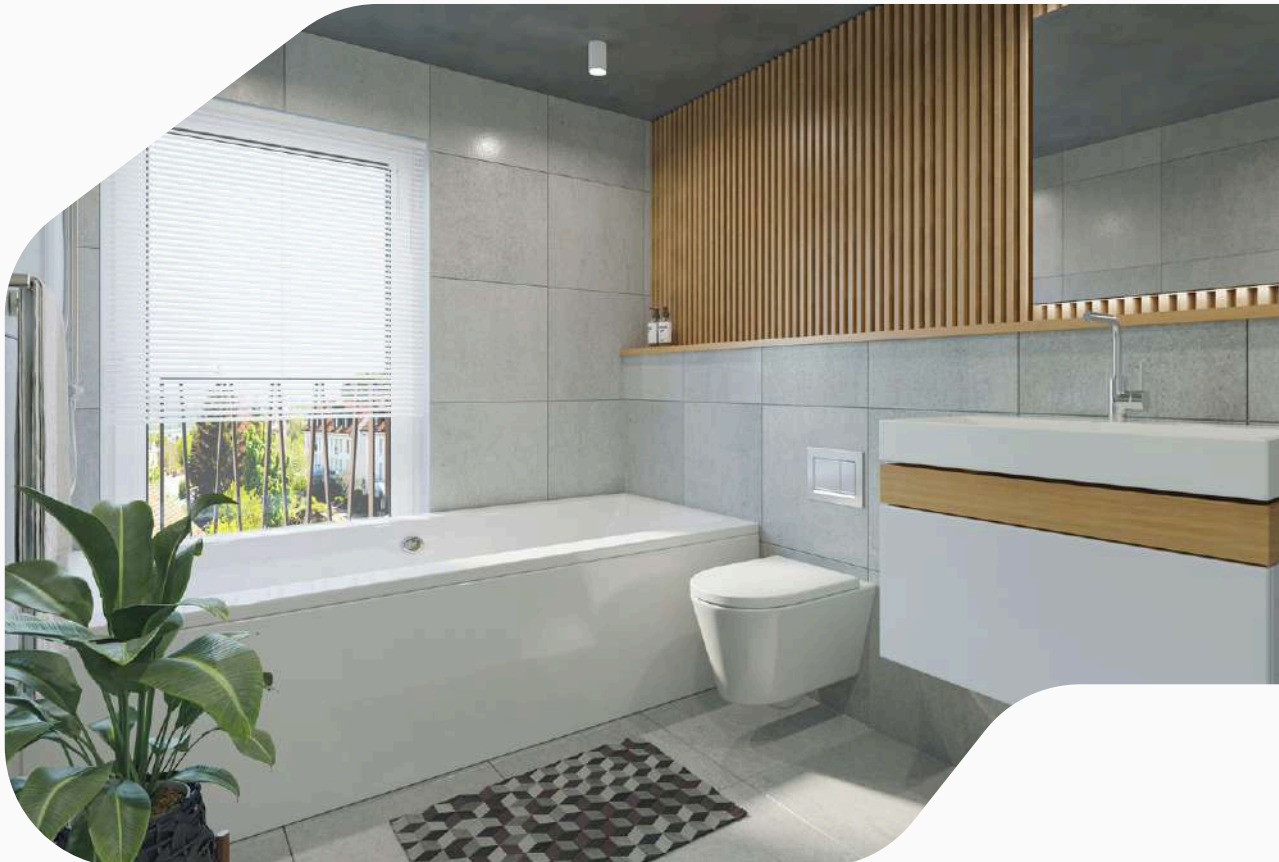


Description

Drainpipe is a high-performance deodorising agent formulated with a water-soluble fixative.

It provides a wide-spectrum action capable of neutralising malodours generated by the decomposition of organic matter within building downpipes and drainage systems.

This liquid formulation is applied directly into floor drains or toilet bowls, followed by a small amount of water to ensure proper distribution. It features a subtle citrus-herbal fragrance.



Application Areas

Applicable to drainage points experiencing intermittent malodour events resulting from organic matter decomposition or sewer-related odours. Commonly used in hospitality environments, particularly hotel guest rooms.



Usage Guidelines

The product is dosed (using the cap provided on the container) directly into the floor drain or toilet bowl, followed by a small amount of running water immediately after application.

This allows the product to adhere to the inner walls of the downpipe, where it exerts its deodorising effect. The product does not clog the pipes, as it is water-soluble and gradually dissolves with the flow of water.

Typically, it is applied once a week during the first two to three weeks, and then reduced to monthly or biweekly applications.

In cases of strong sewage-like odours, an additional application is recommended. The product must be shaken vigorously before each use.

Storage Conditions

Shelf life: One year in its original sealed container, protected from light and stored at a temperature below 25 °C.

Stability under use conditions: Six months.
