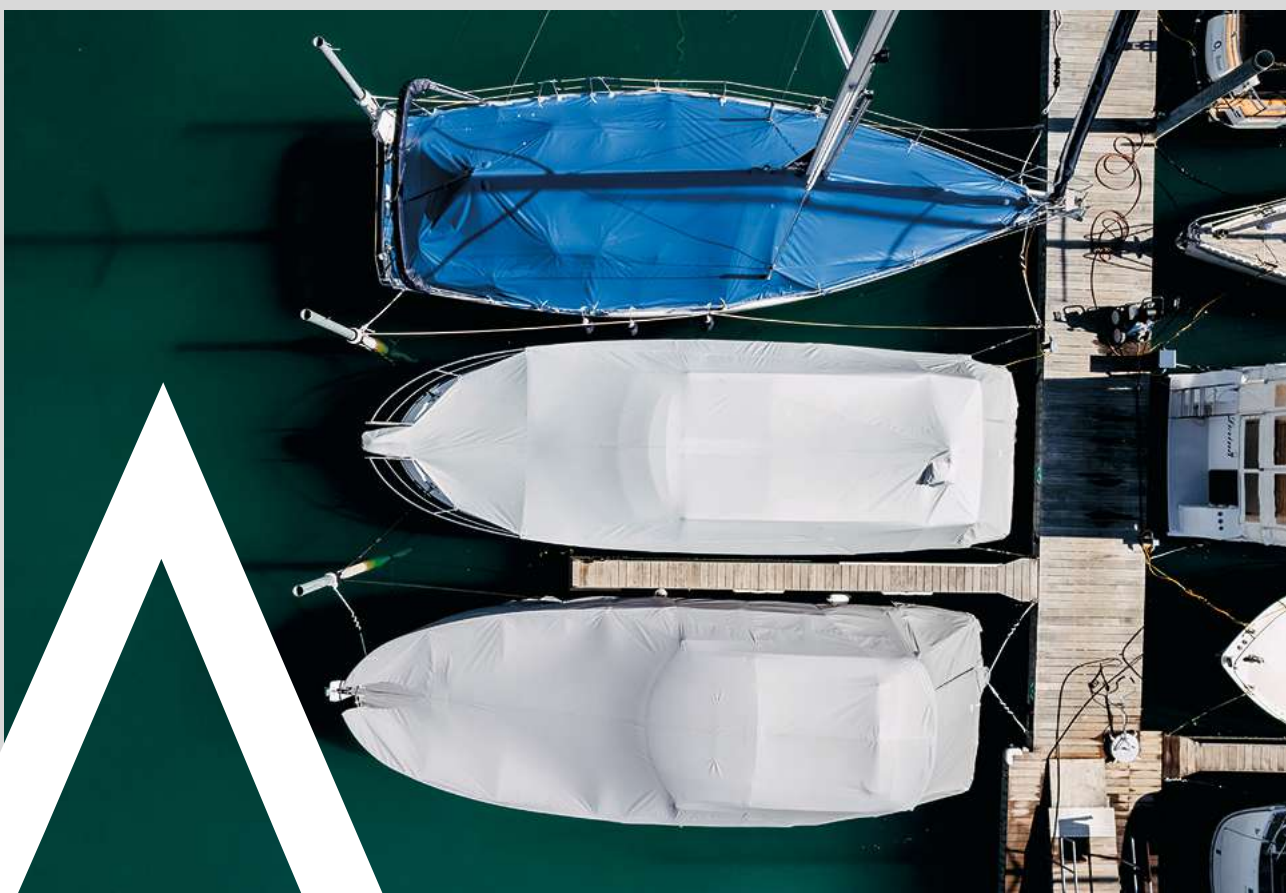

Wind, rain, solar radiation – sometimes our fabrics are exposed to the most adverse conditions, especially when they are used outdoors. At the same time, they have to be functional: lightweight, durable and easy to handle.

Our PLANOFIL® tarpaulin fabric is exactly that type of all-rounder. Thanks to a special ecological PU coating and web structure, it offers perfect protection, is tear-resistant, waterproof and UV-resistant (sun protection factor of 40+).

One square metre of the fabric weighs just 190 grams, it can be folded small and stored away. This makes the tarpaulin fabric one of the most lightweight fabrics of its kind and means that it is the preferred material for use as a cover for boats and outdoor furniture. With careful handling and gentle cleaning, PLANOFIL® is a durable companion.



# PLANOFIL® THE OUTDOOR MATERIAL

The starting point for our PLANOFIL® tarpaulin fabric is a lightweight ripstop polyester fabric, which is significantly more UV-stable when compared with other materials. It absorbs hardly any moisture and its shape does not change, even when wet. The service life and colour depth are also increased thanks to the dyeing for all PLANOFIL® fabrics. For this, colour pigments are already admixed during the manufacturing process, and these combine with the fibre material. This is how we ensure that the fibres are dyed through into the depths of the fabric, meaning that PLANOFIL® remains light-fast and colour-fast. Finally, the fabric is coated with selected ecological PUs, re-waterproofed and sold as rolls (approx. 50 linear metres in length and 179–180 cm wide).

Originally developed for the Swiss Army, PLANOFIL® has quickly become a true all-rounder thanks to its extremely practical properties. Today, the fabric is used especially often in boat-building as a cover or sailcloth and is used to protect items kept in outdoor areas.

Thanks to its textile inner side, PLANOFIL® glides easily and with little effort over all surfaces without getting caught. Furthermore, even larger covers can be folded up and stored with little space required. Saddlers and boat-builders value PLANOFIL®'s great workability since it is flexible and easy to handle.

PLANOFIL® is dirt-repellent and practically cleans itself. This is guaranteed by special water-repellent equipment that has non-stick properties. Even stubborn dirt cannot stick to the covers and is usually washed away again the next time it rains. This means that no washing agents or chemicals are required for cleaning – a special feature for the sake of our environment.

## Cleaning and care

### Quick cleaning

Remove soiling as soon as a stain appears. In the case of stubborn or older dirt, clean with a very soft sponge and cold water.

### Tap water

Do not use any conventional cleaning products or detergents, only cold tap water. Never clean or rinse with seawater.

### Hand wash

Never clean with steam cleaners or pressure washers. Also must not be washed in the washing machine.

### Store dry

Must be completely dry before being folded up.
